President's Message

Once again, change seems to be the theme of these reports. As the Island grows so does our neighborhood. Many new homes are being constructed and more planned nearby. Most notably the Surfside Crossings project continues to loom over our area with many consequences confronting us. The ZBA , the only Nantucket Board to rule on the application, has closed the Public Hearing and will soon vote for or against the project. The applicant can appeal to the State, so the battle will continue. This issue is one we need to be following closely, as the outcome will affect all of us.

Additionally, we note that the Richmond Project is moving along at a steady pace and as it grows so does the traffic it produces. This puts pressure on Old South Road, which spills into our neighbor roads. We are seeing more traffic every day, and the roads are showing signs of wear and tear. The Town planned to repair and replace some roads, but even after passing at Annual Town Meeting, funding, which required a waiver of Proposition 2 ½, was not approved by the voters at the polls. We need to continue to work to get these roads repaired.

Thirdly, change has come to our Landfill in the way we have to separate what we discard. New procedures have been established to try to extend the life of the Landfill and reduce the cost of the operation.

To help inform our members on these issues, our Speakers for our July 13, 2019 Annual Meeting at The Star of The Sea Hostel will be The Director of Public Works Robert McNeil who will update us on our road situation, and Department of Public Works Recycling and Solid Waste Coordinator Graeme Durovich who will discuss the changes happening at the Landfill.
